ABOUT OUR TOWN



Whitefish is located in the heart of the Northern Rocky Mountains of Montana, serving as the gateway to **Glacier National Park**. Our community has seen rapid growth, with a 2025 population estimate of over **9,200 residents**-a 17.5% increase since 2020.

Recreation Hub: Home to **Whitefish Mountain Resort**, which features over 3,000 acres of skiable terrain, and **Whitefish Lake** which offers Whitefish City Beach plus Whitefish Lake and Les Mason State Parks.

Active Lifestyle: Residents enjoy 47 miles of the **Whitefish Trail**, championship golf courses, and year round activities at the **Stumptown Ice Den**.

Community Spirit: From the **Winter Carnival** to **Summer Huckleberry Days**, our town is defined by its strong sense of community and over 500 local businesses dedicated to sustainable growth.

Economic Base: Historically a railroad and logging town, Whitefish now thrives as a major recreation and cultural center with a world-class dining and arts scene.

Accessibility: Despite its perceived remote location, Whitefish is located in Flathead County, the fourth largest county in Montana (county seat: Kalispell, population 32,000) with **Glacier Park International Airport** just 10 miles away.

Whitefish Schools comprise a highly-rated public district with an enrollment of 1,959 students. We are committed to a "student first" philosophy, ensuring that each student makes academic progress every year.
